



Thursday Night Net Script

Good evening and welcome to the Barron County Amateur Radio Association's Thursday night net. This net is held on the 146.715 repeater near Barron, the 444.450 repeater near Rice Lake, the 146.955 repeater near Askov MN, and connected Allstar and Echolink nodes.

Check-ins from all licensed operators are welcome. Net control this evening is *(CALLSIGN)*, my name is *(NAME)*, and I am located in *(CITY)*.

Our association has a website that can be visited at bcham.org. Check out the website for information on our association and news of interest to the local amateur radio community.

Meetings are held bi-monthly. Our next meeting is on *(date/time/location)* and all are welcome to attend. Check the website for the meeting location and the link to attend virtually.

If the 146.715 repeater goes down, the net will move to the Rice Lake repeater on 444.450 with a DCS tone of 351.

This net may be broken for emergency or priority traffic at any time. Is there any emergency or priority traffic at this time? *(Brief pause)*

Are there any announcements for the net? *(Brief pause)*

Optional: At the end of the net we will be playing Amateur Radio Newline or ARRL Audio News.

Are there any in and out, mobile, or short time check-ins? *(Do this once then go to general check-ins)*

I will now start taking general check-ins. Any stations wishing to check in call *(Your Call)* at this time.

(At the end of the list ask for any more check-ins a couple times if nobody else comes back, end the net)

Hearing no more check-ins I will close the net. We had ____ check-ins this evening. Thank you all for participating and we look forward to hearing you again next week.

(Optional: Immediately after closing)

Please stand by for Amateur Radio Newline *(or ARRL Audio News)*.
